### THE PURPOSE OF MARRIAGE

#### The Biblical marriage is about:

- 1. Reflecting God's image
- 2. To have (sexual) intimacy, friendship, partnership, fun and faithfulness in service of God
- 3. To display the Gospel



#### **EPH. 5:22-33**

22Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. 23For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior. 24Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit in everything to their husbands. 25 Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, 26that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word,

27so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish. 28In the same way husbands should love their wives as their own bodies. # STATISTICS ON ABUSE AND VIOLENCE

#### Violence and abuse:

- 1 in 3 women in US have experienced rape, physical violence, and/or stalking by an intimate partner in their lifetime
- 1 in 4 women have experienced severe physical violence by an intimate partner

- A women is less intelligent or competent then husband





### THREE MAJOR OBSTACLES

- 1. She wonders: 'will I be a doormat?' He wonders: 'why can't she see I'm tired of not hearing 'you just don't get it'?'

- 3. She thinks: 'Can I ever forgive him?'
